Four databases available at the library which give access to **academic journals** are available via Google Scholar:

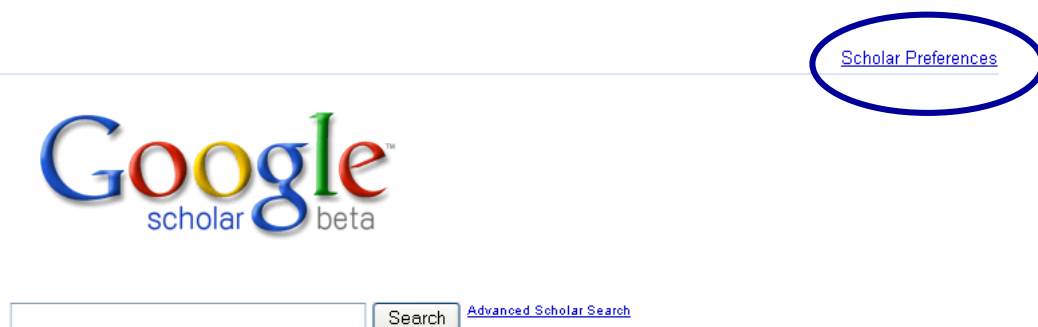
- Business Source Complete

3. Configure the access to the library's electronic resources via Google Scholar

- Click on "Scholar Preferences"



- From the heading "Library links", enter "HEC Paris"
- Click on "Find library"

- You will be directed to the link resolver page. It will allow you to access the library’s electronic resources
- Click on the link “Find article” to access the article
- **Note:** the link showing the database name (here, EBSCO Business Source Complete and Factiva) allows you to access the homepage of the database. “Find title” links you to the list of issues in the journal in which the article has been published
